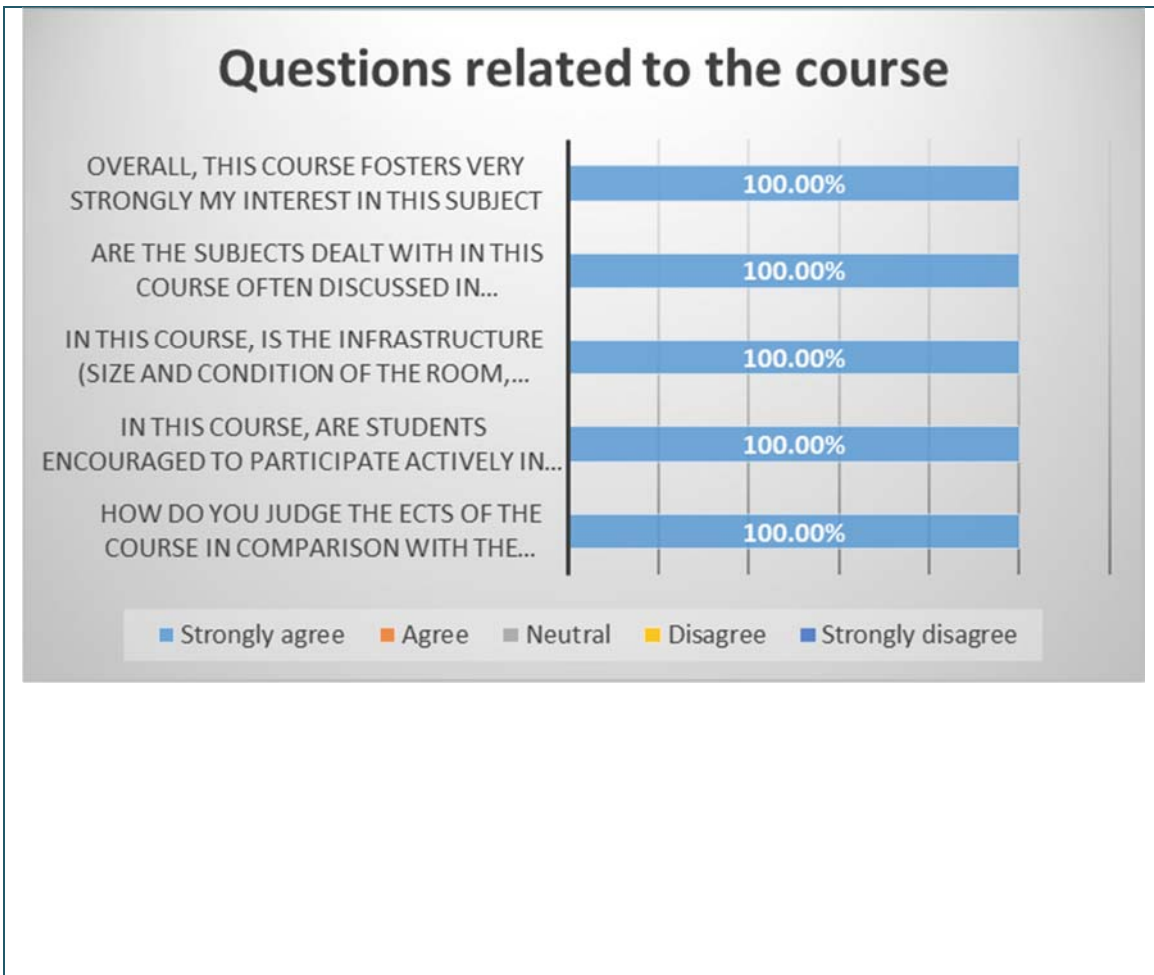

Results of general evaluation of implemented course

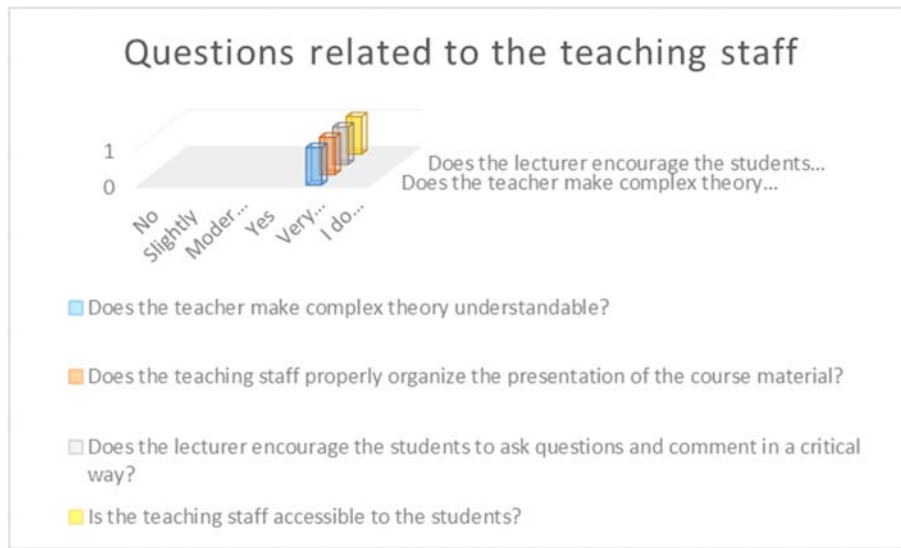
Description


Results of evaluation of teaching staff
