



QUALITY ASSURANCE AND MONITORING

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OVERVIEW

- **1)** Internal quality assessment will include peer reviews performed by the Quality Assurance Committee (QAC) consisting of members from following partner HEIs: NMBU, UACEG, UNIRIFCE and UL as a WP5 Leader.
- Reports on the project quality progress will be delivered by all project participants, twice a year. QAC will prepare quality reports twice a year after its meetings and send them to SC.



- **2)** External quality assessment will be enabled through continuous presentation of the project activities and deliverables on the project website, as well as their publishing in public media (newspapers, journals, electronic media etc.). External evaluator will be subcontracting for the external evaluation of achieved projects results.
- According to the internal and external monitoring and quality control, the QAC (if necessary) will take measures to improve the quality of the project realization. The external monitoring and peer reviews, as well as the project reports, will be available on the project website.



- **3)** Inter-project coaching will be implemented i.e. Consortium members will contact the members of running and/or completed Erasmus+ projects in similar fields in order to use their accumulated expertise and to undertake a peer review.
- Quality Assurance Committee meetings will be held twice a year and open for the participation of representatives of all Consortium members.



- Standards and Guidelines for Quality Assurance in the European Higher Education Area, developed by ENQA (European Association for Quality Assurance in Higher Education), adopted by the Bologna Process Ministers in 2005, will be taken as reference, as well as the key quality assurance principle of continuous improvement.

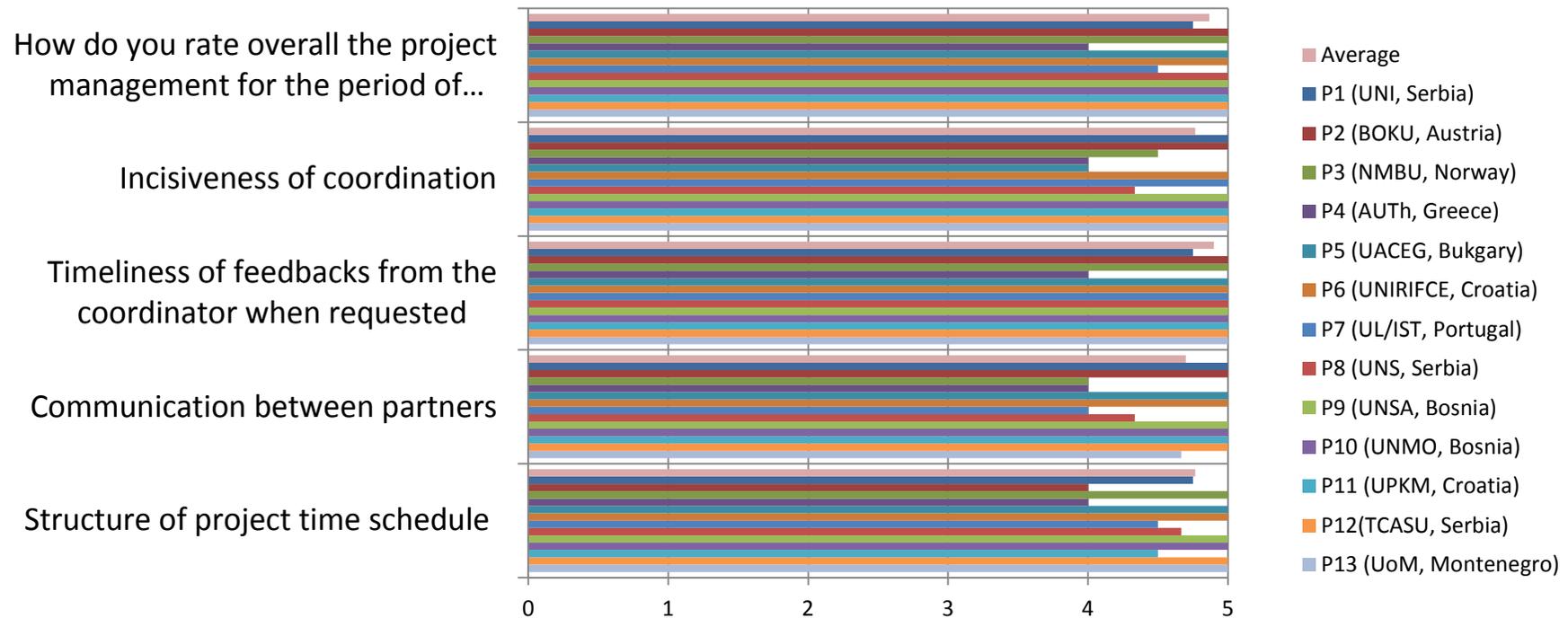

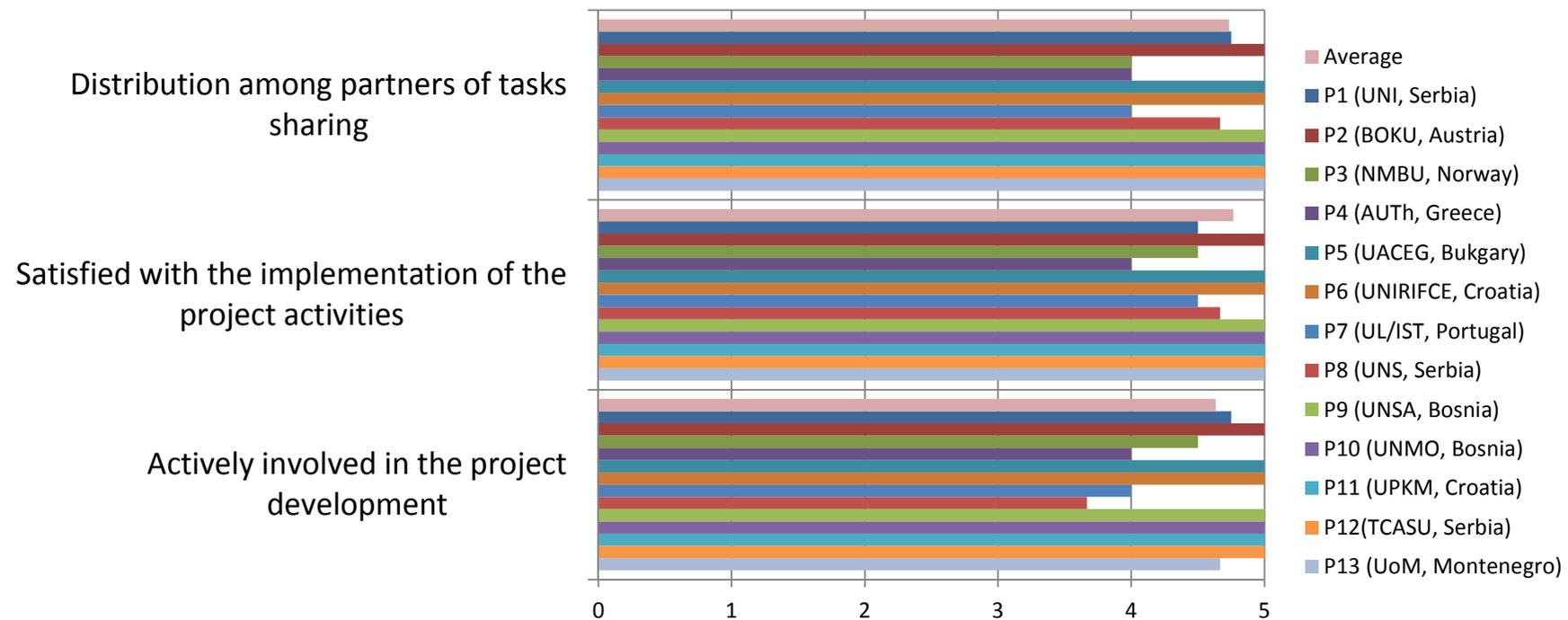

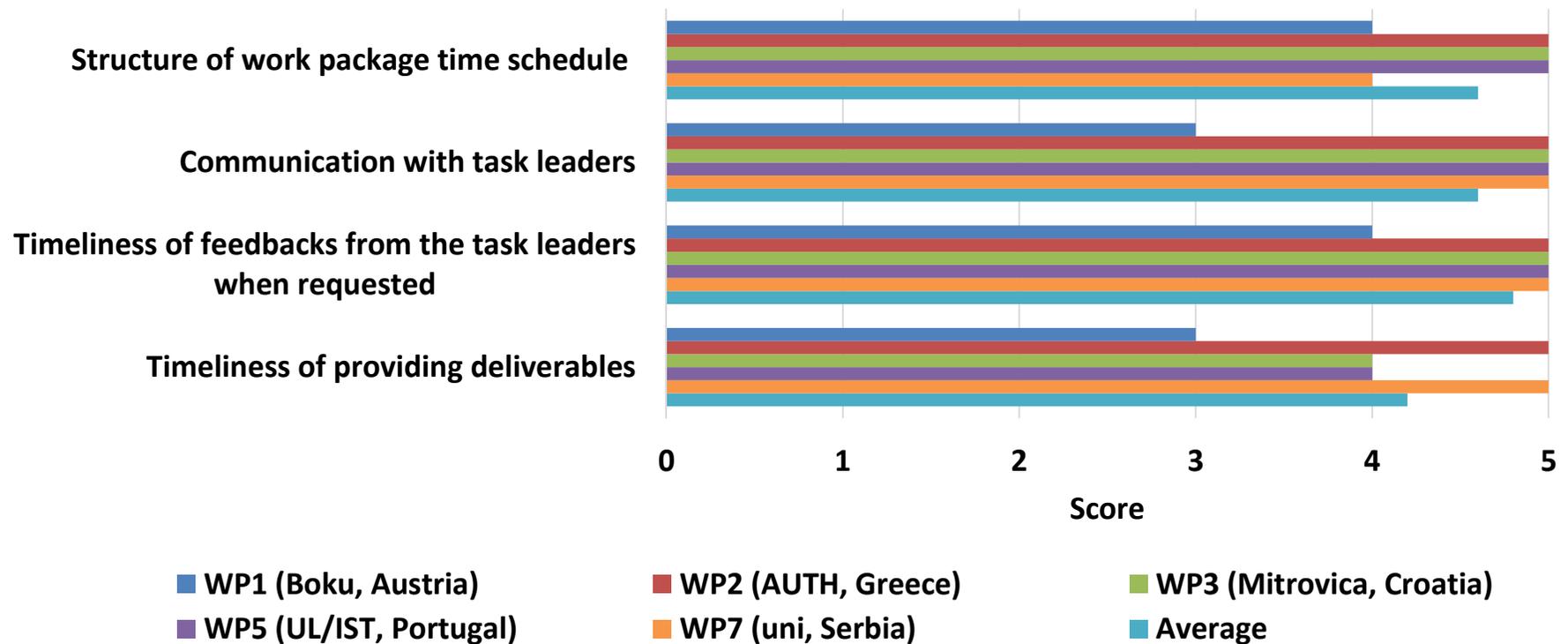
