Event description:

As a part of the WP 6 Dissemination and exploitation, A6.4 Roundtables with non-academic sector, UPKM has organized a session with representatives of local companies. The roundtable was organized on 25th of June 2021 and lasted from 12 h to 15 h in line with the previously prepared roundtable agenda.

The participants of the roundtable were representatives of 6 institutions: Municipality of Kosovska Mitrovica (Department for Urbanism), Public Utility Company Standard, Municipality of Zvecan (Department for Urban planning and Inspection, Department for Environment, water and forestry), Trepca Company for Mining, Metallurgy and Chemical industry and UN Habitat office in Zvecan and Faculty of Technical Sciences Department for Environmental engineering.

At the meeting, participants were introduced with the main objectives of the SWARM project and new UPKM study programmes developed under the SWARM project. Jelena Djokic explained to participants the structure and the learning outcomes of the new study programmes and how these skills and competencies could be used in the water sector.

After that, Jelena Djokic introduced the EU Water Policy under the Water Framework Directive and EU best practices in the water sector. The topic of general discussion was implementation of EU Water Framework Directive in the water sector in Serbia.

Participants expressed the interest for new study programmes and concluded that future graduated students will have opportunity to work on water quality programme and in general in sustainable use of water. The final remarks were regarding the possible cooperation with the municipalities in drafting and submitting the project proposals for financing under IPA III programme, considering the water production and waste waters treatment.


Description


