- The IWA is headquartered in London, UK, with a global secretariat based in Nanjing, China, and a regional office in Chennai, India.



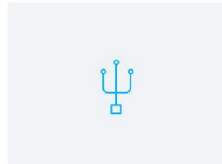

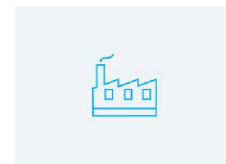

The YWP community is a dedicated group within the IWA Network where many activities are organised by, and for, young IWA members (aged 35 years and below).



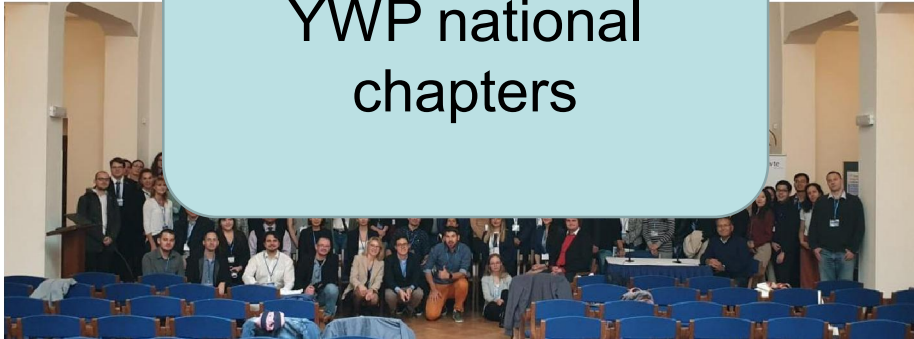
