After the PMC and QAC on-line meetings, meeting with the WB partners was organised in order to present future tasks and discuss eventual problems that can happened during the project realisation.

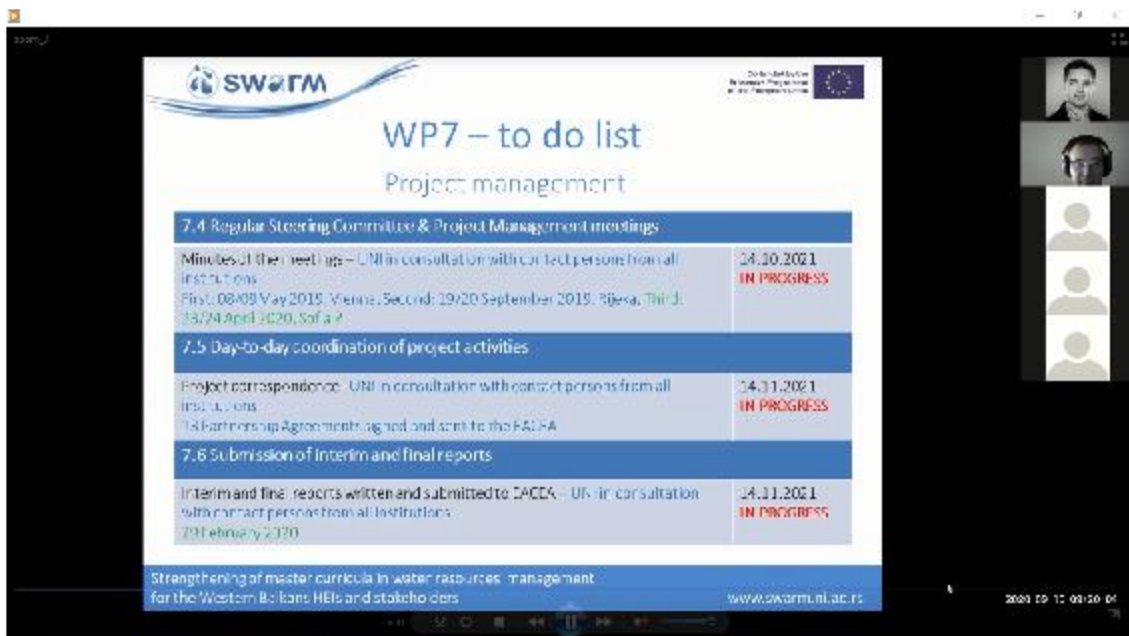
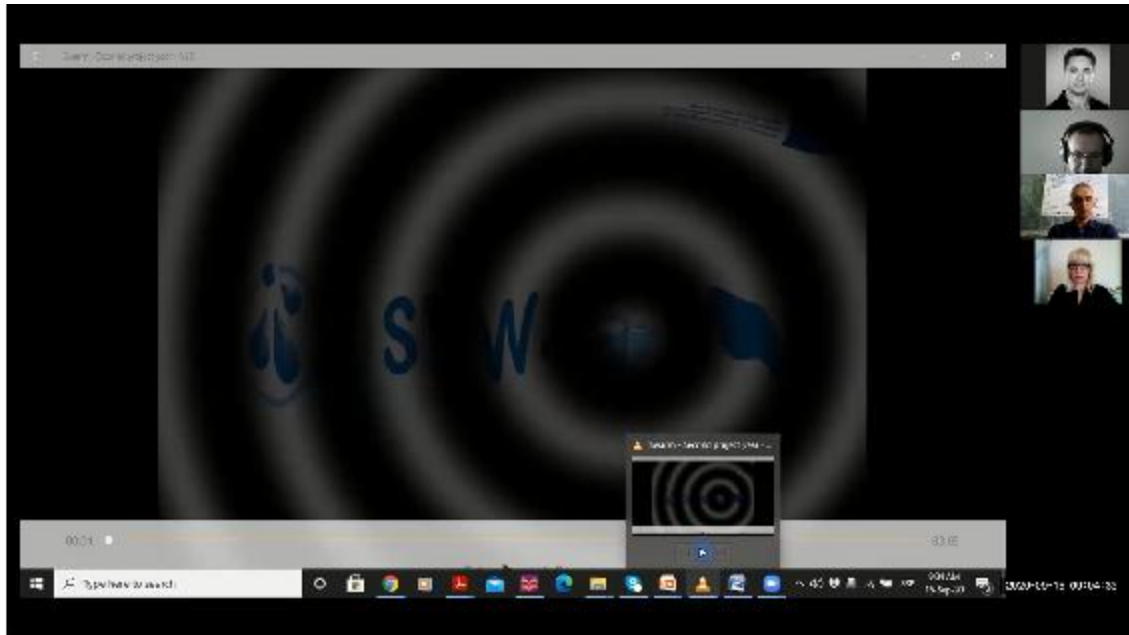
