 - 6 theme-based trainings for teaching staff from WB HEIs
 - ✓ Held in 5 EU countries and in Norway
 - √ 3-days training
 - ✓ To be done until April 2020
 - The staff training in UACEG is the first one
 - ❖ 29th -31st of May 2019 ongoing today!
 - ➤ 6 winter/summer schools for students from WB HEIs
 - ✓ Held in 5 EU countries and in Norway.
 - ✓ 5-days long
 - ✓ To be done between January and September 2021
 - ❖ UACEG to welcome students in 2021



5. Expected Results

- Life Long Learning (LLL) Courses for professionals in water sector
 - Developed courses
 - ➤ At least 1050 participants (on average 150 per WB HEIs)
- Theme-based training for teaching staff
 - > 90 trainings for at least 17 teachers from WB
- Winter/Summer Schools
 - > 120 trainings for at least 78 students from WB countries



5. Expected Results

- New subjects (courses)
 - > 15 new courses developed
 - Implemented in master curricula
- Updated or new master curricula for WRM
 - Accredited curricula (study programs)
- Laboratory Equipment
 - 7 laboratories in WB HEIs modernised / updated
